### Updated Policy for Children's Restroom Etiquette

We have adopted a new policy to stay in line with Colorado guidelines and keep our children as safe as possible.

The children's restrooms are to be entered by the children and teachers only. There are no parents allowed in the children's restrooms for any reason. Should a child need assistance, please ask for help from one of the four teachers: Mrs. Martinez, Ms. Jodie, Miss Jill, or Ms. Tammy. Adult restrooms are located through the eastern double-doors in the gym, to the left, opposite the nursery room entrance. If you think your child who is a student, or a sibling, will need help from you, please bring them to the adult restrooms with you.

We realize that the faucets are currently very hard for little hands to turn on and off, and they often require assistance from parents. We are currently getting estimates and will be having the faucets replaced soon to alleviate this problem.

You will see signs posted this week that reinforce this new policy. The rules have been added and highlighted in the [Parent Handbook](#) on our website and on the bulletin board. Please contact a board member or teacher with any questions.
